The generosity of our members and supporters is a key factor in the strength of our organisation. Donations over \$2 are tax deductible.



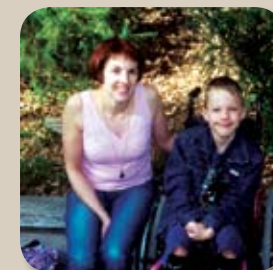
