

## Getting a COVID vaccine for children with additional needs or disability



Extra help is available for families with children with additional needs or disability to get a COVID vaccine.

COVID vaccines are free and available to all children aged five and older.

## **Getting help from a Disability Liaison Officer**

Disability Liaison Officers can help everyone in Victoria with a disability.

This is a free service.

There are no restrictions based on immigration status. Children do not need to be NDIS participants to get help from a Disability Liaison Officer.

Disability Liaison Officers can:

- Make sure the vaccinator understands your child's needs
- · Help you get a longer vaccination appointment
- · Help children who have a fear of needles
- Make a vaccination appointment where it is quiet and calm for your child
- · Find a vaccination centre that is easy for your child and family to use
- Help with transport to get to your vaccination appointment
- · Arrange vaccination at home
